Susan Arena, President of the Foundation, enthusiastically announces the installation of the third automatic door opener at the **Beacon Cove Elementary School in Jupiter, FL.** Horton Automatics, Inc., Based in Corpus Christi, Texas, donated the device as well as the installation.

This is the second donation given by Horton Automatics. On April 22, 2007, Horton donated *and* installed an opener for the **Maltz Jupiter Theatre.**

These events are significant since 18% of the population in Palm Beach County alone, have mobility issues they face on a daily basis.

ADA (American's with Disabilities Act), a Federal Law, does not require automatic door opening devices to be installed in any door. While many States have passed their own legislation to require these openers be installed in all public buildings, Florida has chosen to ignore this very real and unnecessary problem.
